## Adoption Procedure

If you think you're ready to adopt, our Adoptions Coordinator is here to help! Just follow these easy steps:

*Today*, take photos of any animal in the shelter you are interested in adopting. You can also check KAPS fostered animal listings on [www.animalrescuekorea.org](http://www.animalrescuekorea.org)

*Email* your inquiry, along with your photos or a link to the ARK profile, to the adoption coordinator at [KAPS.Adoption@gmail.com](mailto:KAPS.Adoption@gmail.com)

*Complete* the adoption application that that adoption coordinator will provide you with.

*Watch* your inbox – the adoption coordinator will conduct an email-based interview.

*Approved* for adoption? Your adoption coordinator will schedule a meeting between the Coordinator, yourself, and the animal of your choice.

*Review* and sign the adoption agreement, smile for your adoption photo, and pay the adoption fee.

*Congratulations!* Now all there is to do is enjoy the company of your new pet.

*Please Note:* The adoption process takes approximately 5-7 days to complete.
